When we come to Easter and Holy Week, instead of focusing upon Palm Sunday we will be spending time around the Jesus on the Cross and then celebrating the Resurrection.

In the evenings amongst the Praise and Prayer times and Emanate services, we will be covering the book of Colossians. Having gone through a series on Healing, it is good to be rooted in this book that speaks of Freedom in Christ and His supremacy over all things.
