Update from HUG (Homelessness Unity Group) - formed by local churches and community groups:

As we enter a new year, we are all too aware of the cold weather that is now with us. As a result it is very likely that the **Severe Weather** Emergency Protocol will be activated frequently over the coming weeks. This will not automatically trigger the **emergency accommodation at the St Barnabas Crypt**, Sea Road as this will only be required if the need to accommodate people cannot be fulfilled through temporary accommodation and B&Bs by Rother District Council.

If you locate a person who is rough sleeping during extreme weather (feels like below 0 degrees Celsius), contact the out of hours number on 01424 787868.
