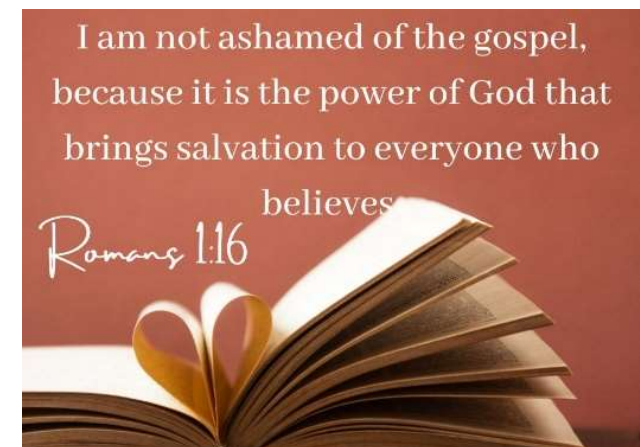
Regular groups - most regular groups are starting to meet up again for 2025. Please keep an eye on the Church Diary (now also on the Beulah Website with more information) for dates and times.
